VETERANS RANKING SYSTEM 2011/2012

Introduction:

The Veterans Ranking Scheme is a "results based" system with points awarded for finishing positions in ranking tournaments, including round robins.

The objectives of the ranking system are to seed ranking events and to give guidance on selection for representative teams.

Seeding for the first tournament of the season will be based on finishing positions in the end of the previous season ranking lists. Each player will start the season with a NIL points score.

Award of Points:

Points will be awarded as follows for performances in ranking events:

Tournaments Qualifying for Ranking Points for 2011-12 :

Veterans Round Robin Tournament, Veterans Provincial Open Tournaments, Veterans National Championships, Veterans events at Senior Provincial Open Tournaments and the Senior National Championships.

Issue of Ranking Lists:

New ranking lists will be prepared and issued within 7 days of each tournament. Tournament organisers will be requested to provide all results in electronic form.
