

This document sets out the procedures for clothing international squads travelling to tournaments (or playing international tournaments hosted in Ireland).

Database:

Clothing Stock Database to be managed by the Table Tennis Ireland Office. Clothing will be stored in the Table Tennis Ireland Office in Irish Sport HQ, Abbottstown. ITTA staff will keep a note and will do regular stock take of all clothing in the office.

Issue of Clothing:

There are two types of tournaments, Full Internationals and Other Events. Clothing should be issued to selected players as follows:

Event Category 1 (Attends Regular international events throughout the year)

• Full Kit: (Tracksuit, 2 pairs of shorts, 2 home shirts, 1 away shirts, 2 training shirts, socks and bag)

Event Category 2 (Attends SSI, PSI, WTT events, Home Nations)

• Full kit (Tracksuit, 2 pairs of shorts, 1 home shirt, 1 away shirt, 1 training shirt and socks)

All international clothing issued to players remains the property of TTI and can be recalled at any stage should the need arise to facilitate other players travelling to international events. However, 1 home shirt, 1 pair of shorts and 1 pair of socks will become the player's property once issued and will not need to be returned at any stage.



Procedure:

The office gives the performance committee a monthly update on who currently has TTI clothing



Team Issued to TTI Staff (6 weeks ahead of tournament)



TTI Staff prepares the clothing—performance committee will confirm to office staff who will need clothing. Clothing for selected players dependent on type of event.



Clothing Collected by National Coach/Player/Players Parents.



Database Updated

Notes:

- International clothing should be worn on international duty/national training camps <u>only</u> – Players should not wear international clothing or use international equipment (bags etc) at domestic events.
- Each invitation to an event will contain information regarding TTI clothing. It is ultimately the responsibility of the player to ensure that the required clothing is in place for each event.
- If a player loses or damages issued clothing, they will be required to pay for replacement items.



• For all international events, players should travel to the event in branded Ireland tracksuits. Enforcing this is the responsibility of the NPC on each event.
